Job Description: Under general supervision of Operations Manager, the position is responsible for the operations transportation, storage and surveillance of Crude oil storage and transportation facilities including the monitoring and operations of storage tanks, movement transactions, pumping equipment and monitoring equipment and various piping components after normal business hours.

- Responsible for inspection and operation of pumps, tanks and piping components.
- Makes visual checks of Tanks, meters, gauges and pump equipment.
- Performs maintenance tasks and mechanical duties (pumps, valves, oil checks, etc.)
- Works with schedulers and third party customers to coordinate operating requirements.
- Coordinates product movement with Dispatching Department, shippers and third party customers.
- Performs quality control analysis, identifies product changes and segregates as required.
- Completes paperwork including, facility balance, meter calibrations and custody transactions involving basic math skills.
